## ABOUT THE BOOK

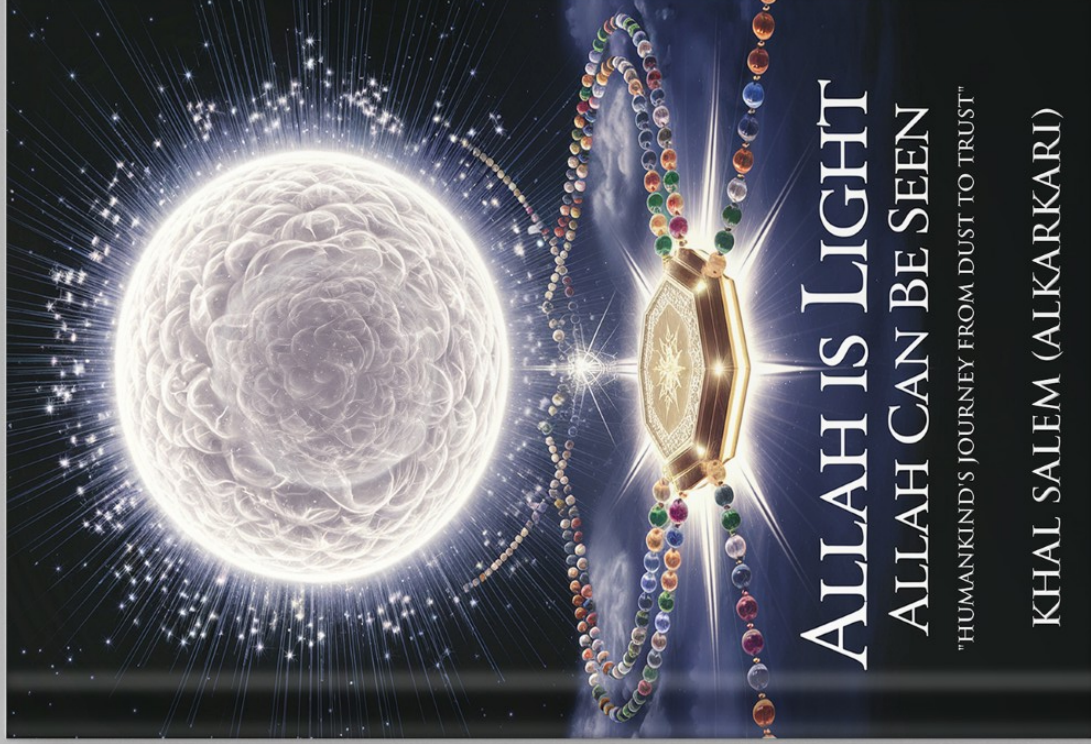
