After cutting, use glue to place the pieces where they belong. Some stay on the same page, and others flip, fold, or move. Just follow the page instructions to help Lila rebuild!

4. Ask for help if you need it

Some pages might feel tricky – and that’s okay! You can always ask a grown-up or big friend to help.

5. Use your imagination

Color the pages, name the characters, or draw your own fairy-tale scenes. You are part of the story now!

6. Celebrate your royal skills

When you reach the end, you'll have practiced amazing scissor skills AND helped Princess Lila rebuild her castle and her kingdom. 🏰 You are a true Fairyland Builder!

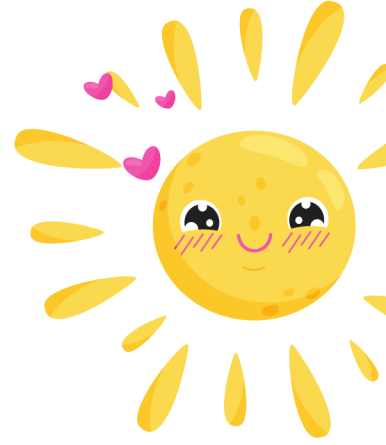

► **Task:** Cut the bridge and make it a drawbridge - it must open if dragons fly by!

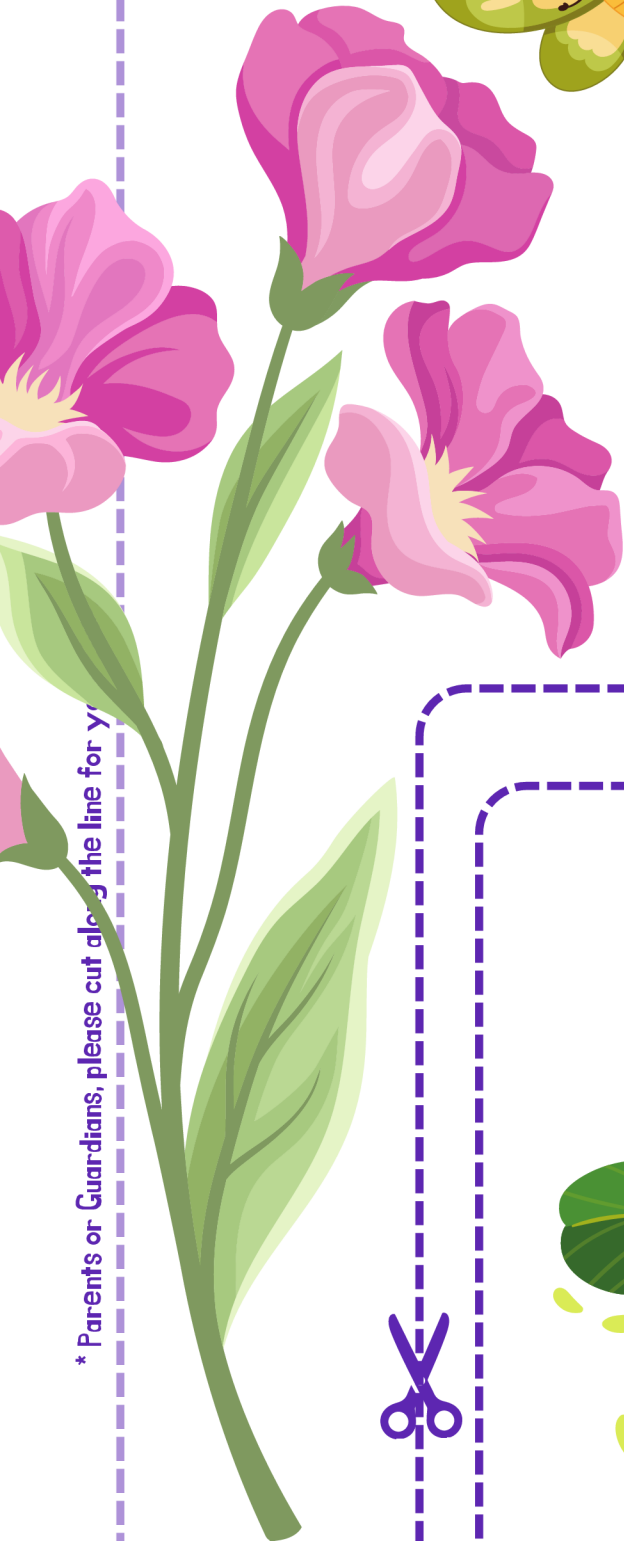
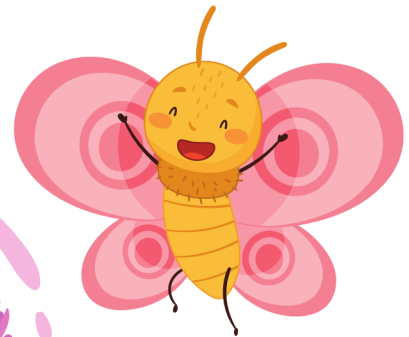

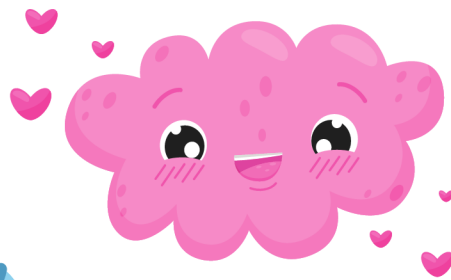

► Lila's teacups are floating up with the clouds!

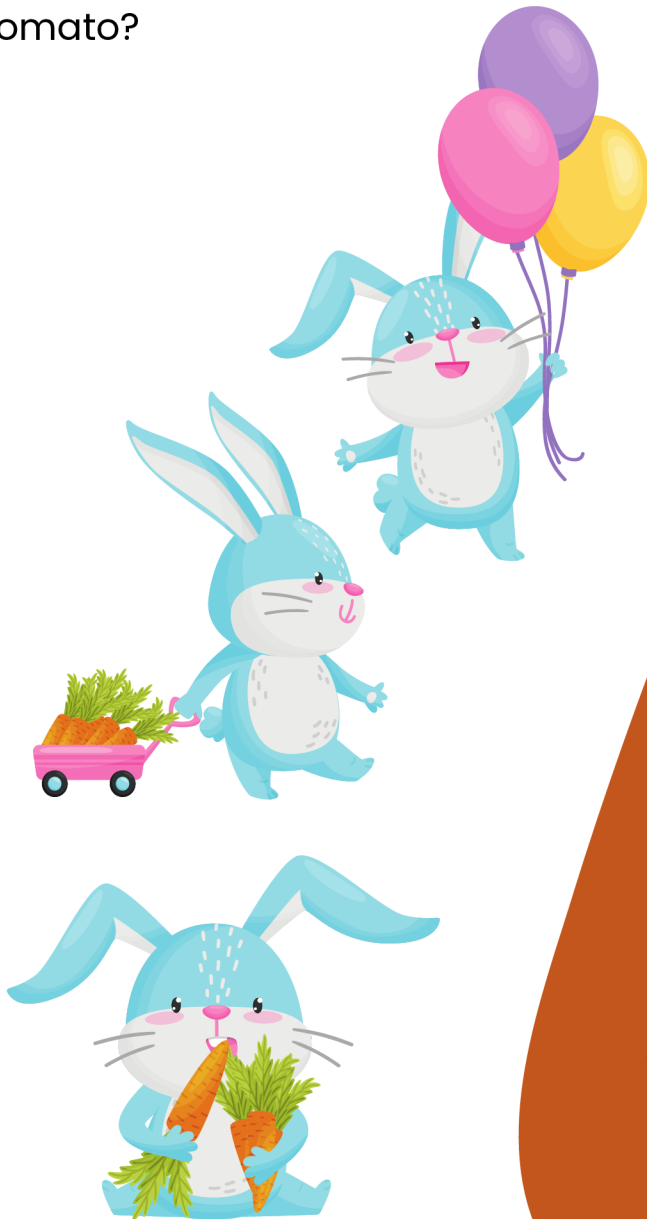
Task: Cut and sort teacups and clouds - can you tell which belong in the kitchen and which in the sky?

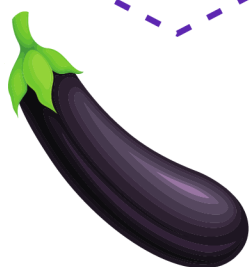
Task: Cut your own path and gently cut the bunnies out of the vegetable patch. Can you guide them home without damaging a single tomato?

Task: Cut carefully along the lines to protect each vegetable. Don't let any go missing - Lila needs every carrot for her sparkle soup!

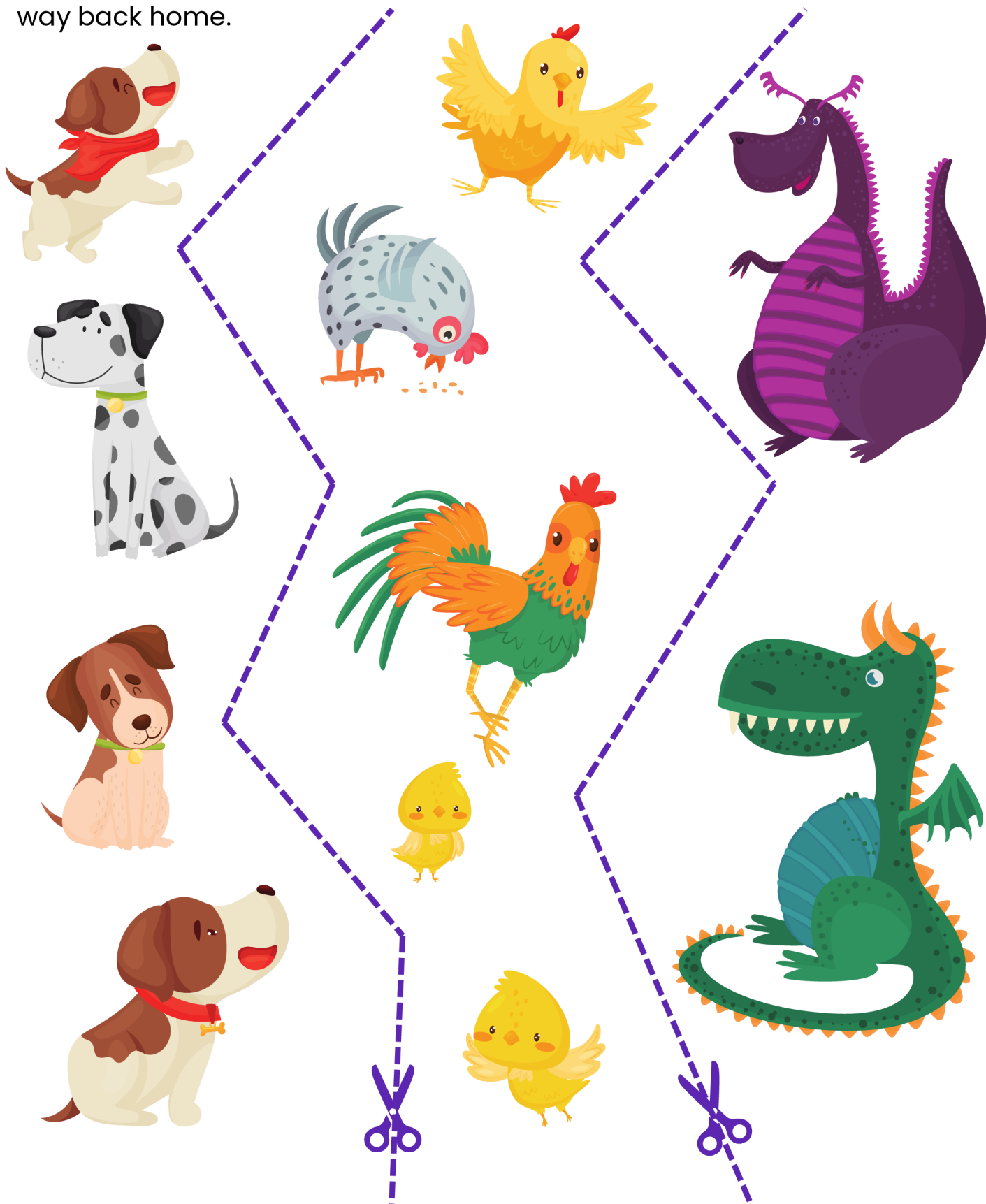

▶ The silly hens wanted an adventure and ran away from the henhouse! Now they're in danger - dogs are chasing from one side, and hungry dragons from the other.

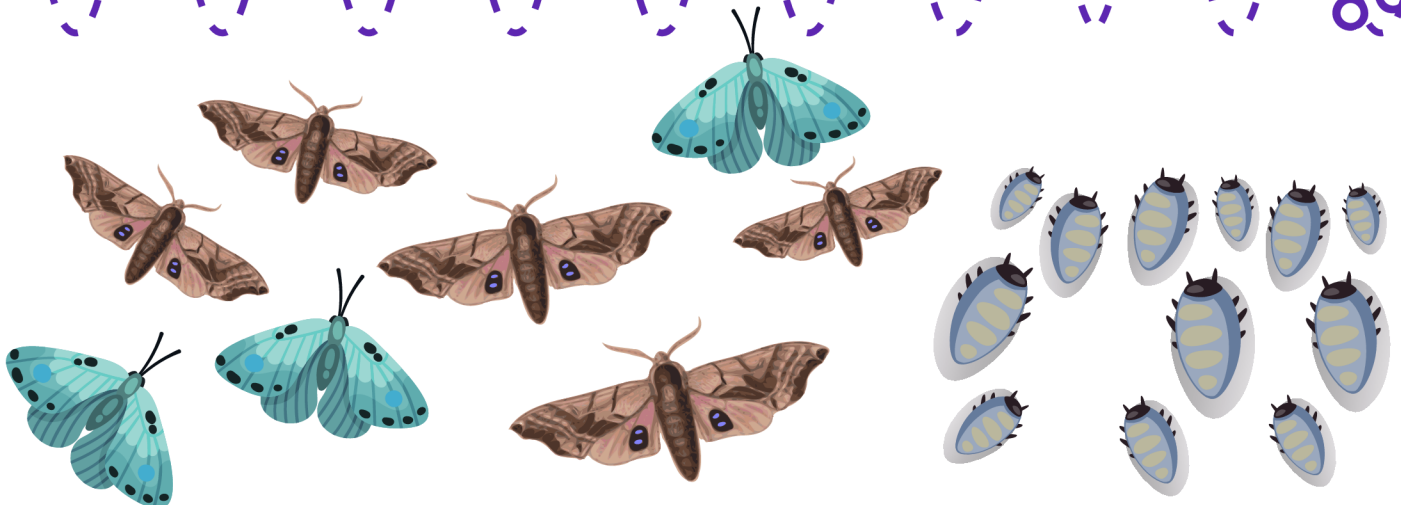
Task: ✂ Cut the page to help the hens escape safely and find their way back home.

▶ The glitter-gust blew open Princess Lila's wardrobe, and now moths and sparkle bugs are everywhere!

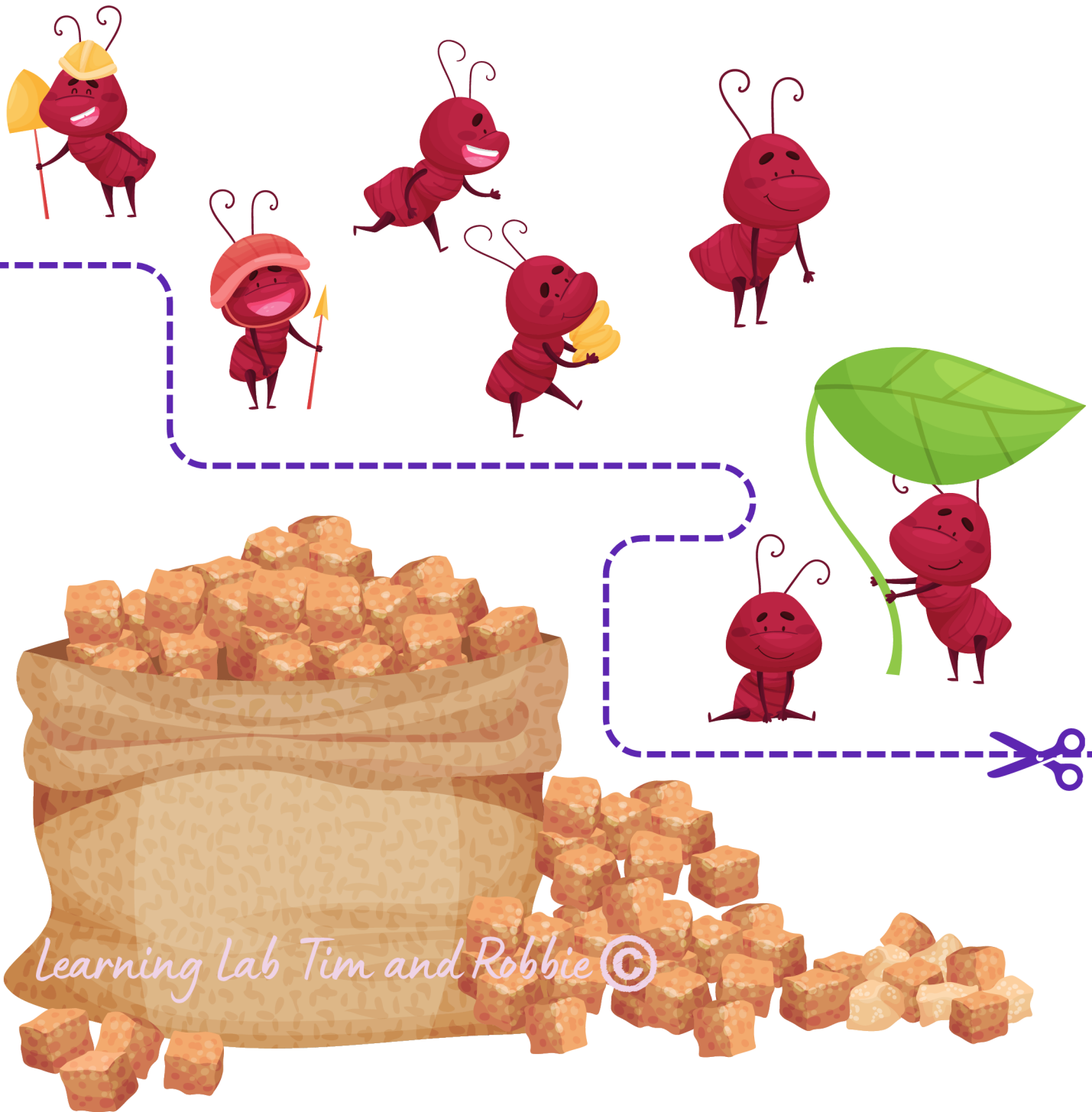
Task: ✂ Cut along the lines to protect her royal robes and shiny throne—don't snip a single sleeve!

▶ Uh-oh! The royal cook spilled sugar all over the floor - and now a line of sparkle-ants is marching straight toward it!

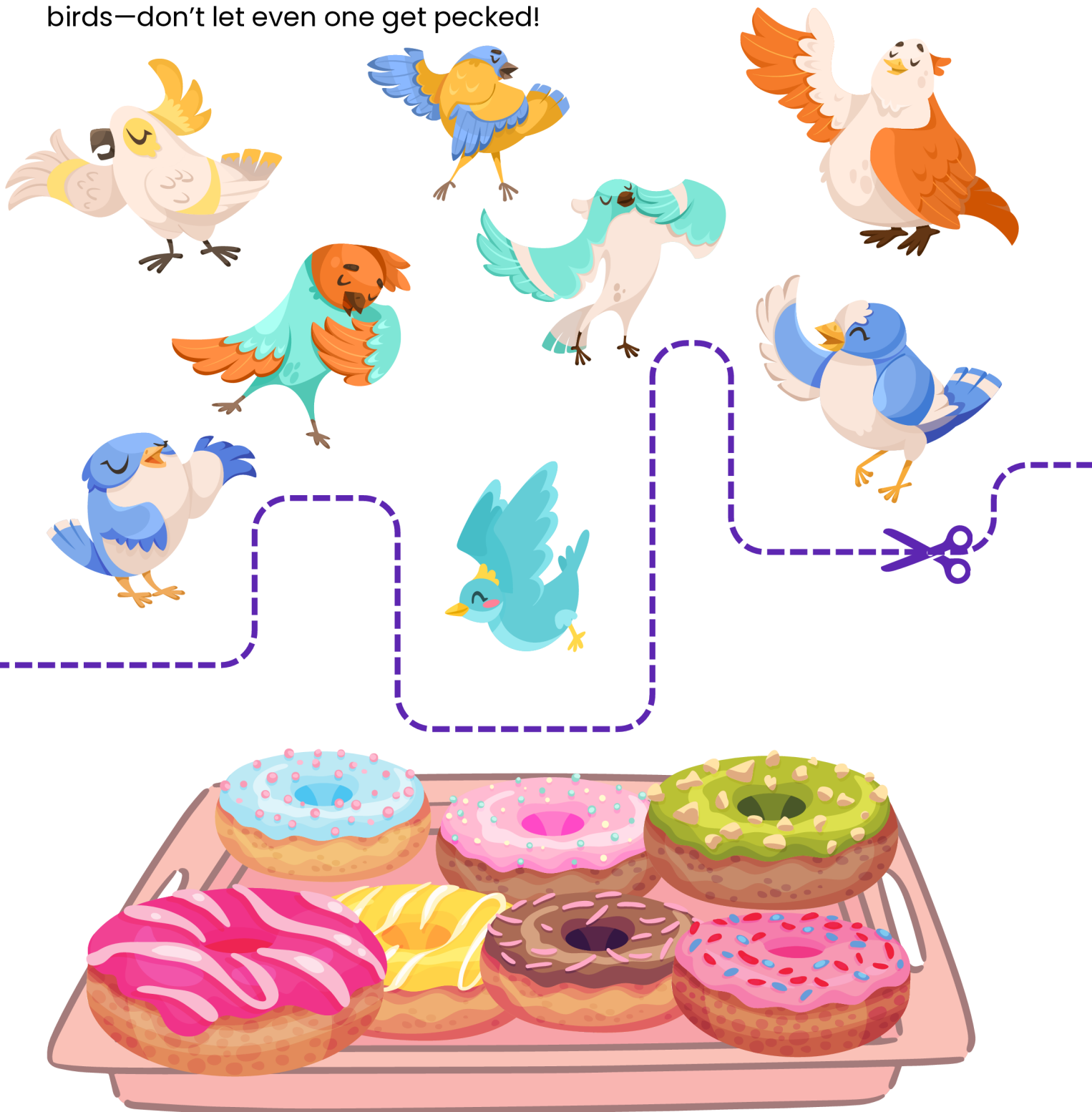
Task: ✂ Use your scissors to block the ants! Cut the paper so they can't reach the sugar pile.

Task: ✂ Cut the page to keep all the donuts safe from the sneaky birds—don't let even one get pecked!

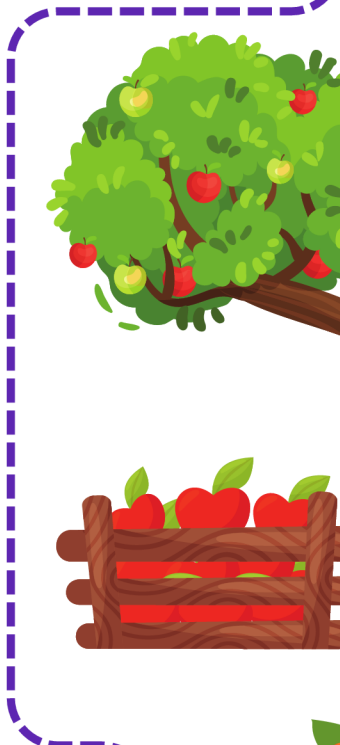
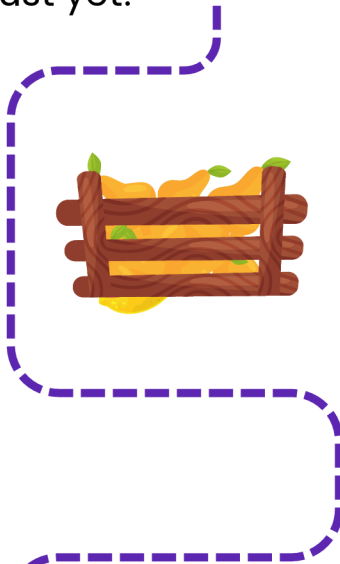

Task: ✂ Cut the page to stop the dragons from sneaking into the vegetable patch. Not a single cabbage can go missing!

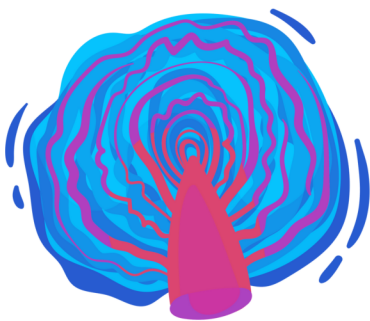
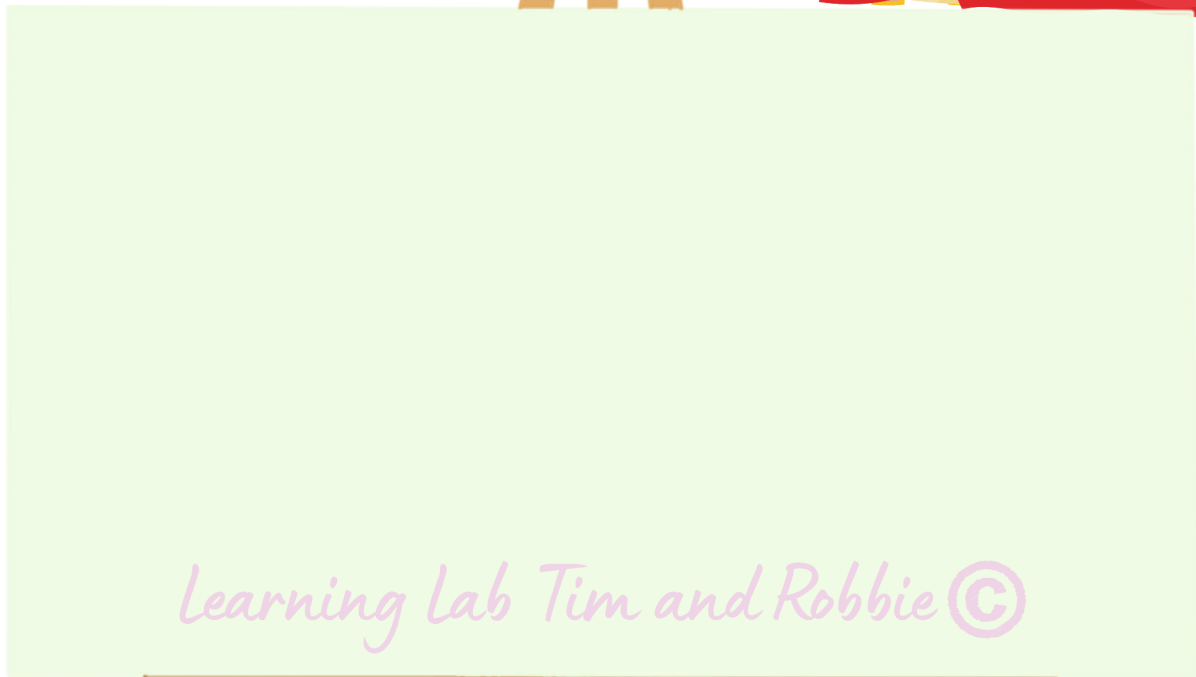


Design Your Own Magical Vegetable!

Task: 🖍 Draw and decorate your own magical vegetable.

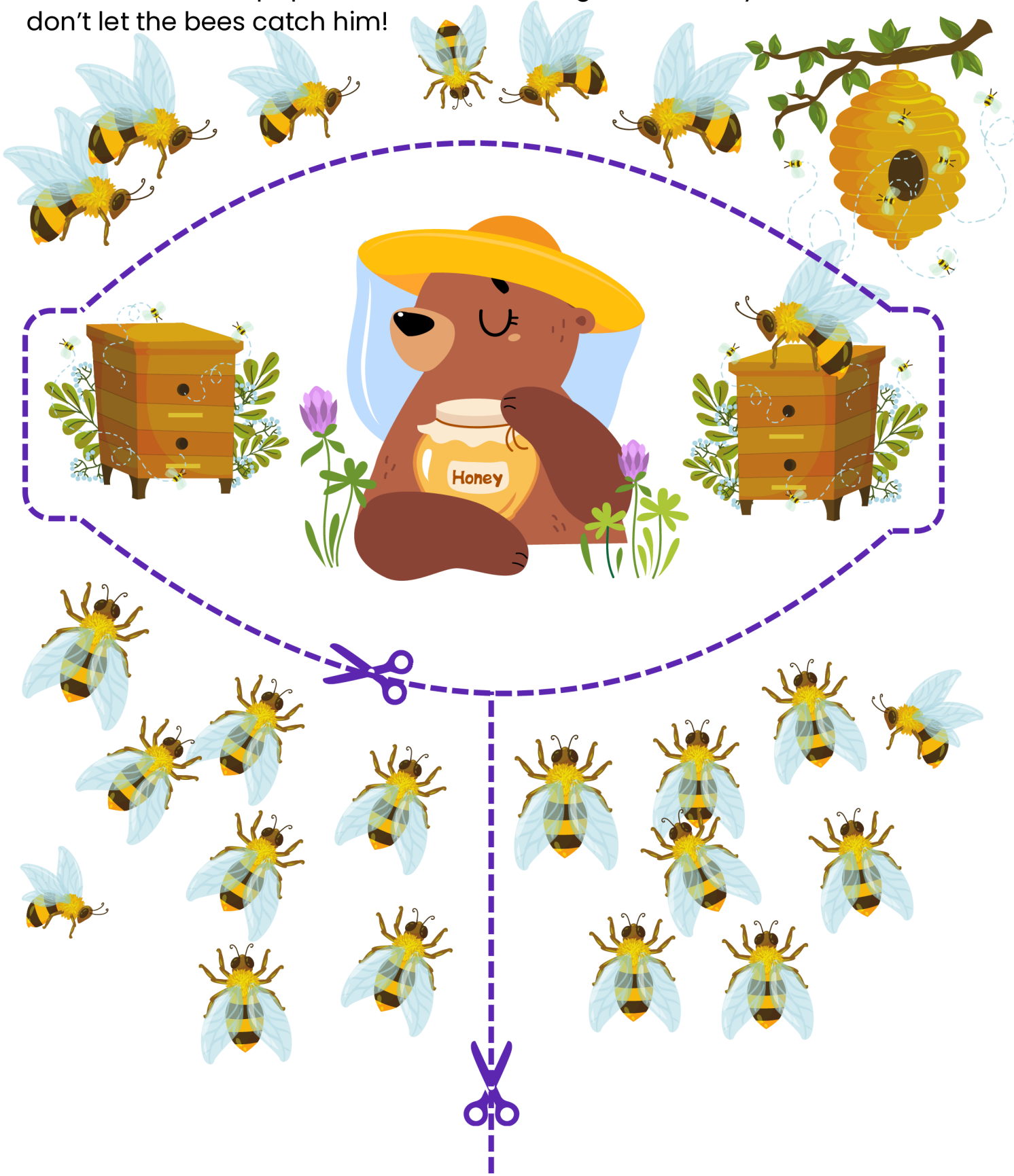

▶ A honey-loving bear has wandered into the royal garden - right to Princess Lila's golden beehives! But uh-oh... the bees are buzzing and ready to chase!

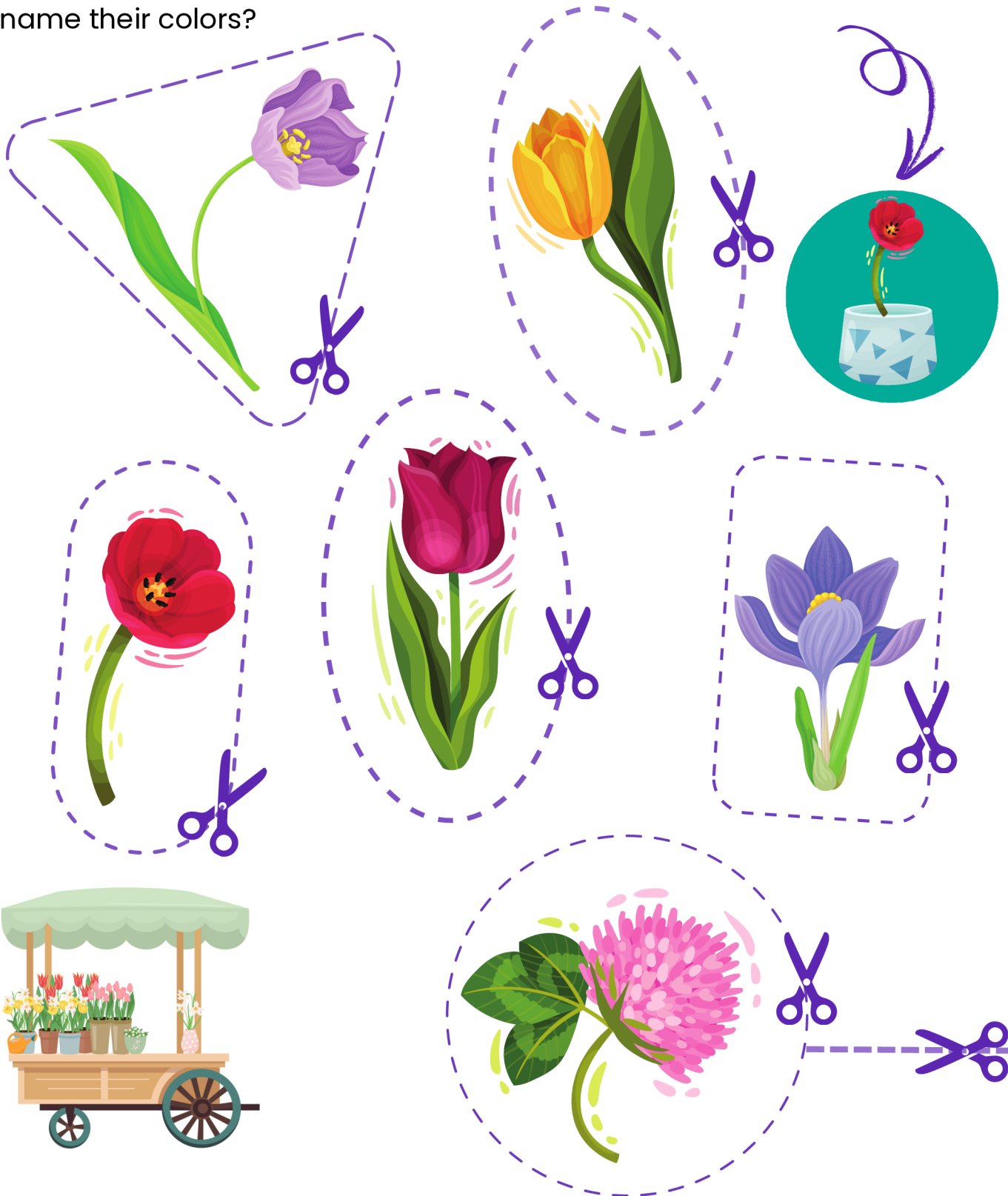
Task: ✂ Cut the paper so the bear can get his honey snack—but don't let the bees catch him!

► The garden used to be full of marigolds and moonflowers. Now it's just... dirt!

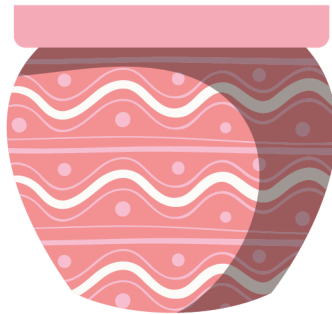
Task: ✂ Cut out the flowers and get ready to plant them in flower pots back where they belong like this (on the next page)! Can you name their colors?



Where's My Garden - Page 2



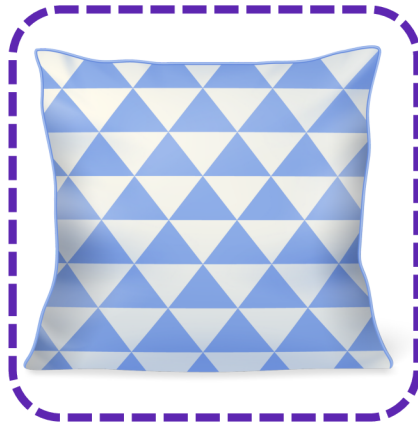
▶ It's time to plant the flowers in pots! Use glue to stick the cut-out flowers into the flower pots on this page. Make Lila's garden beautiful again!

Task: ✂ Cut out and match the right star pattern to help Snork snooze.



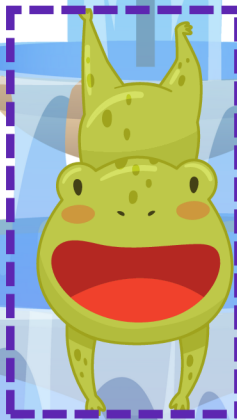
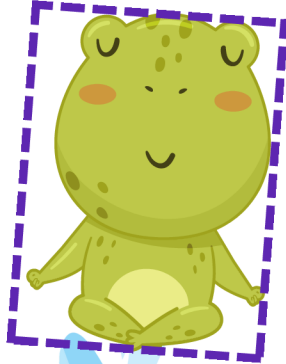

Flying Frogs in the Fountain - Page 1

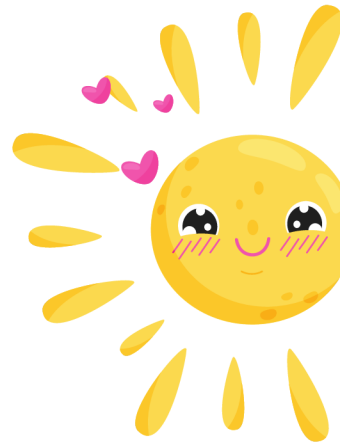
► The fountain frogs got caught in a splash-storm and now they're all mixed up!

Task: Match the leaping poses back to the shadows. Can you spot the one that doesn't fit and leave it out?



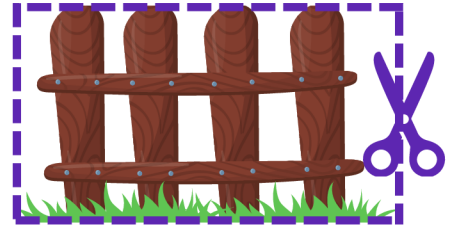
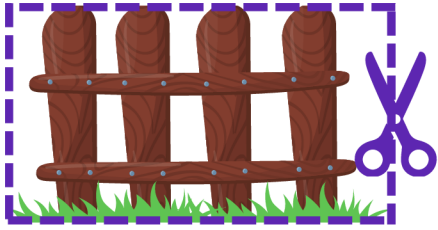

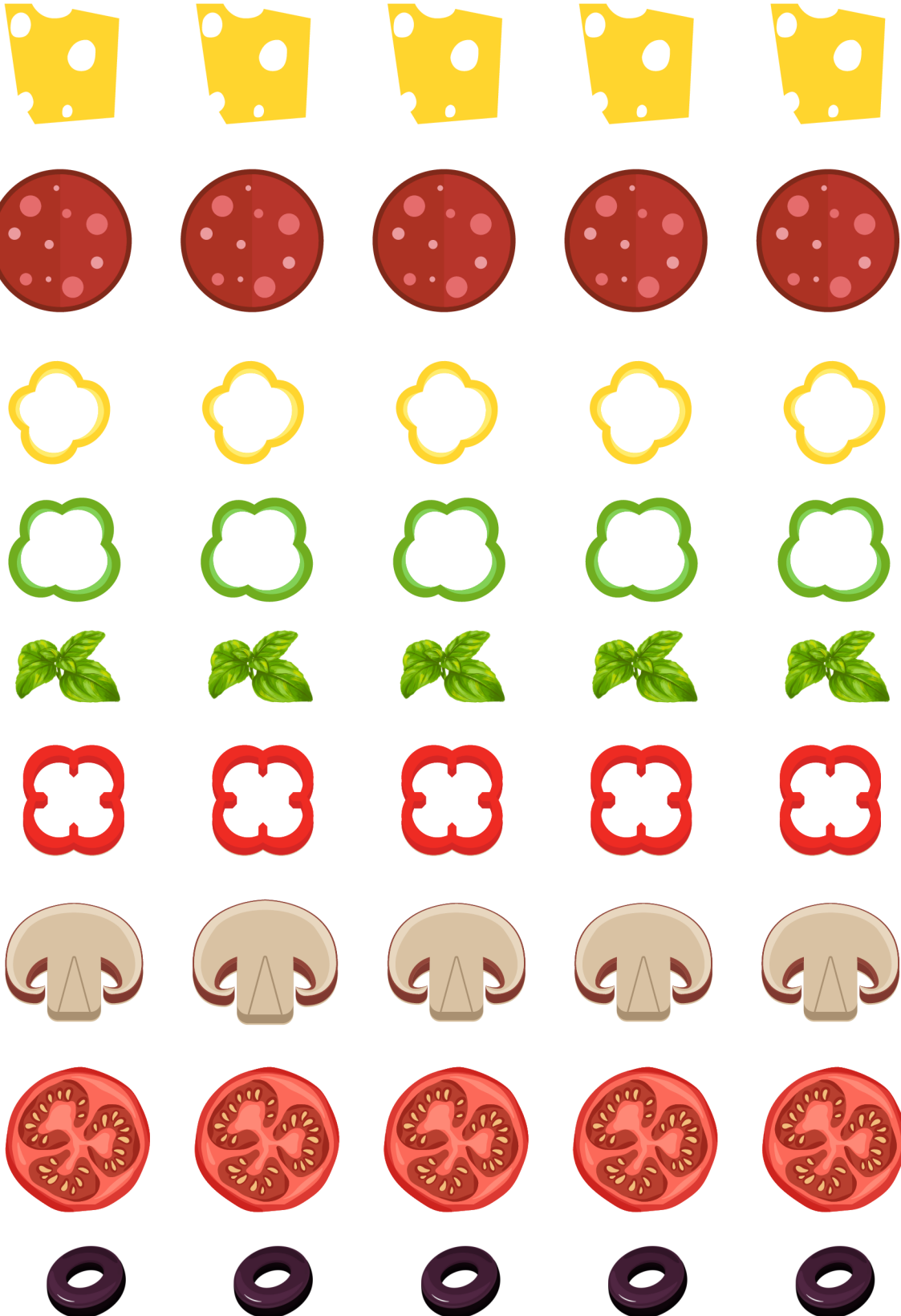

Task: ✂ Cut out the pizza ingredients below and get ready to build a delicious royal birthday pizza!

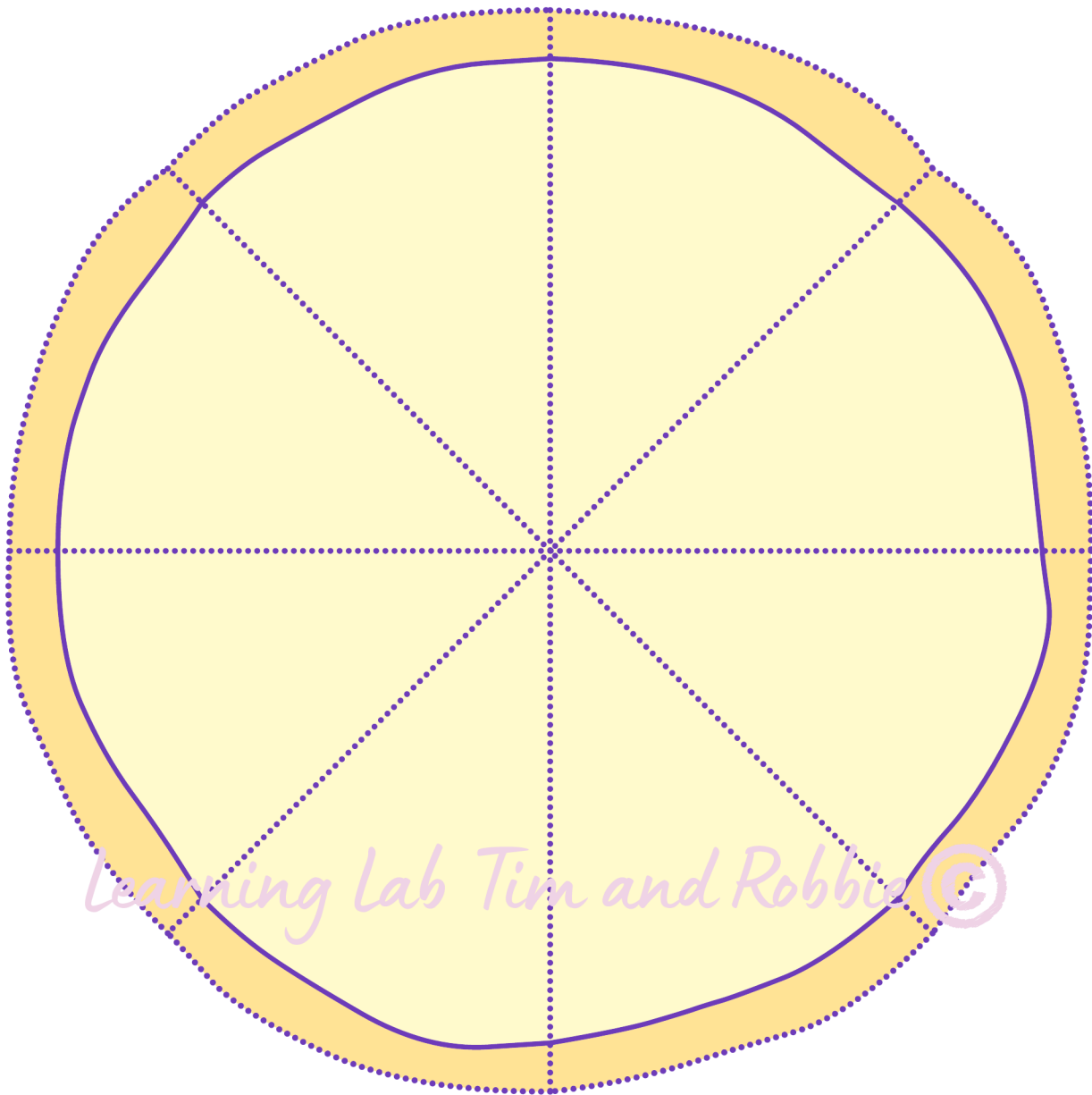
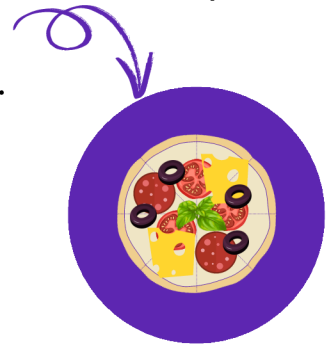

Then ✂ cut the pizza into slices along the dotted lines.

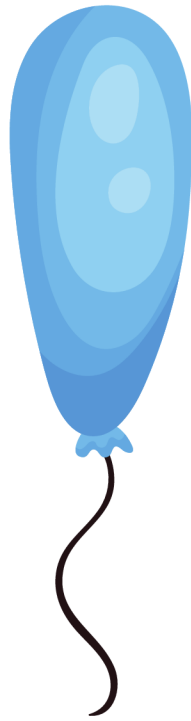
