dreams!' he hummed."**






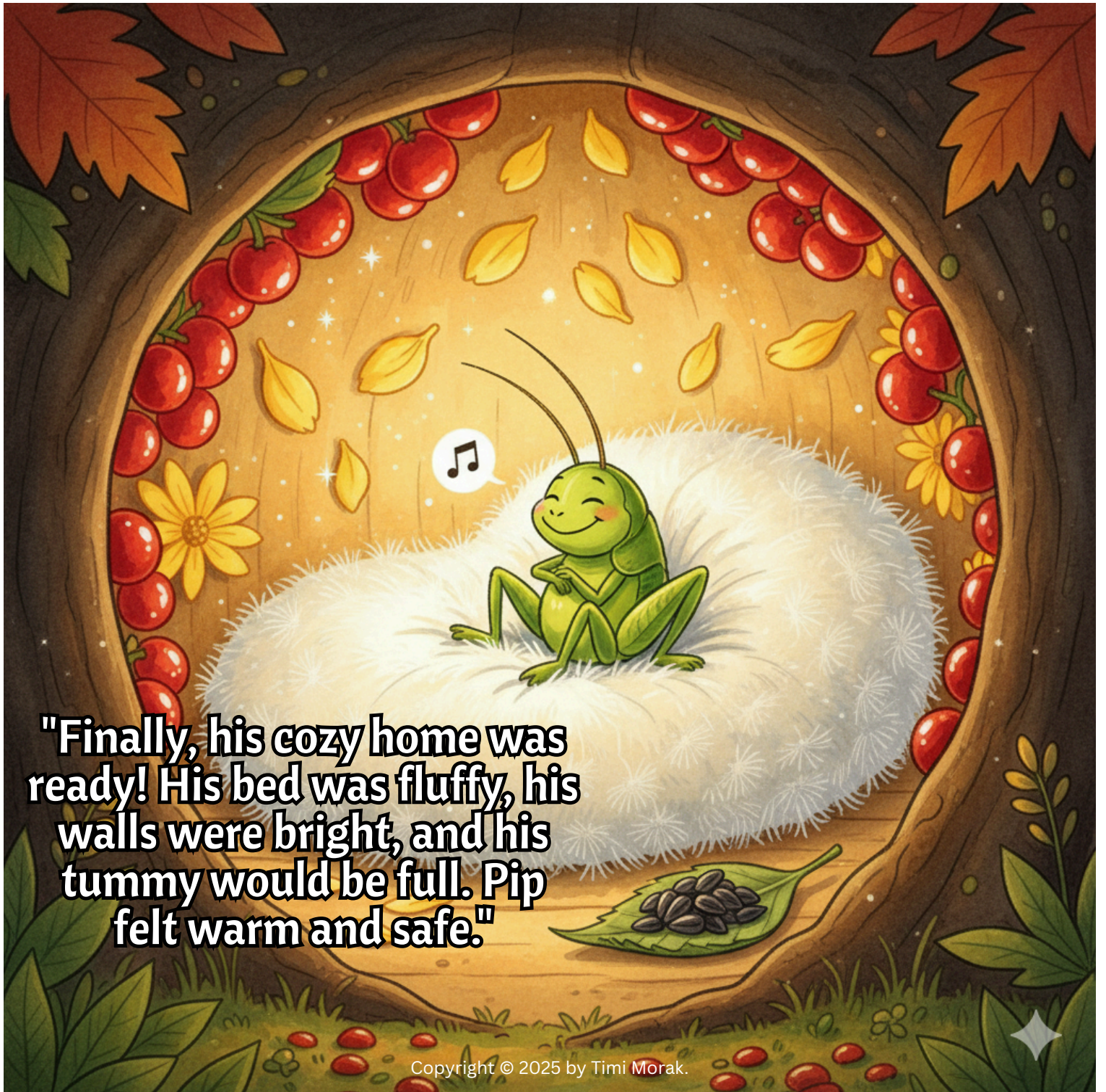
"His bed was soft, but his walls were plain. Pip found shiny red berry skins and bright yellow petals. They made his nook sparkle!"

door!"**






**"Pip carefully peeked out.

creativity!"**



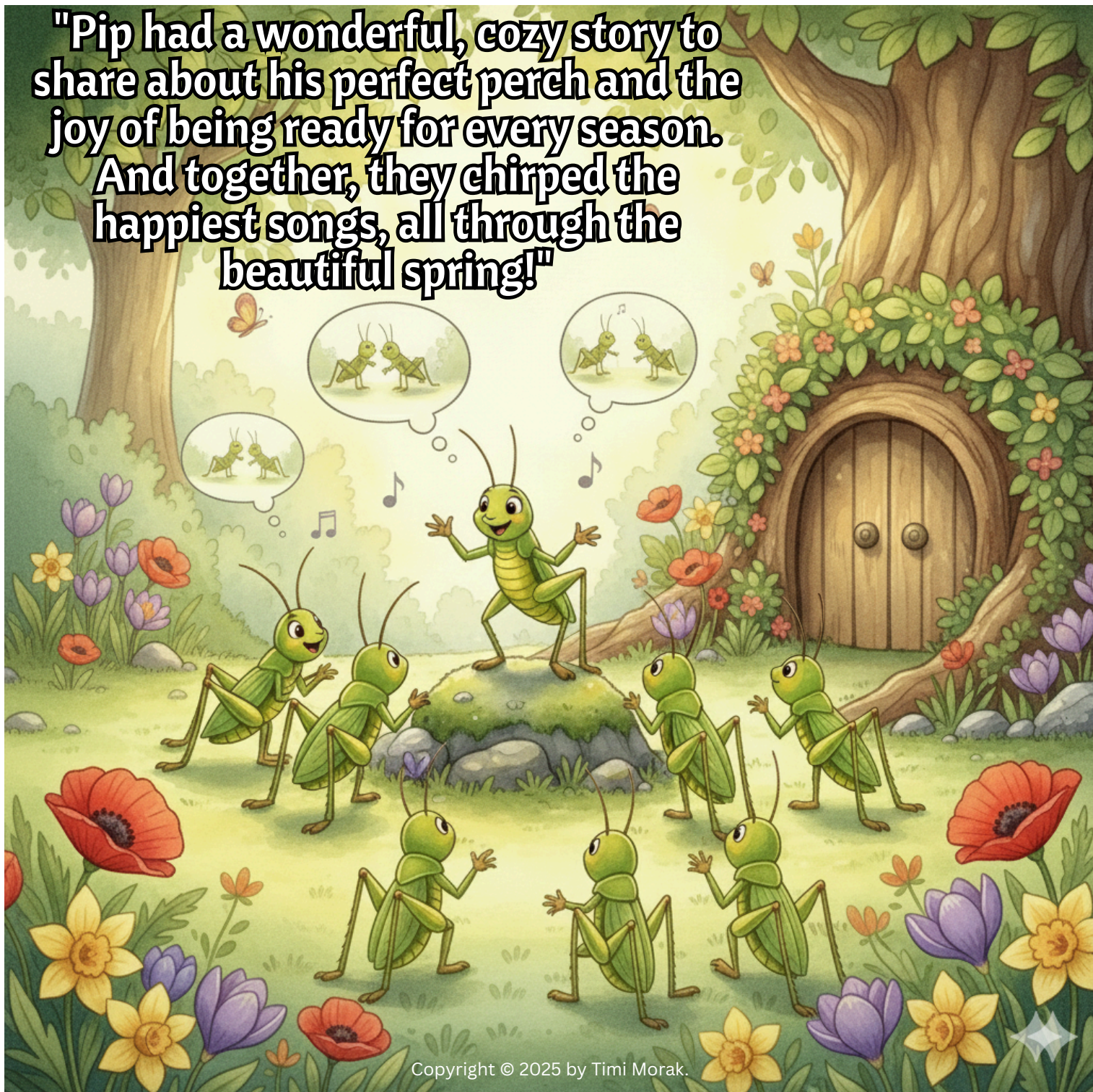
"And listen! What was that sound? Faint at first, then louder... Chirp-chirp! Chirp-chirp!"
