Together, we noticed a flower drooping sadly near the park fountain. "You can do it!" we chanted, watering it carefully like true plant guardians.



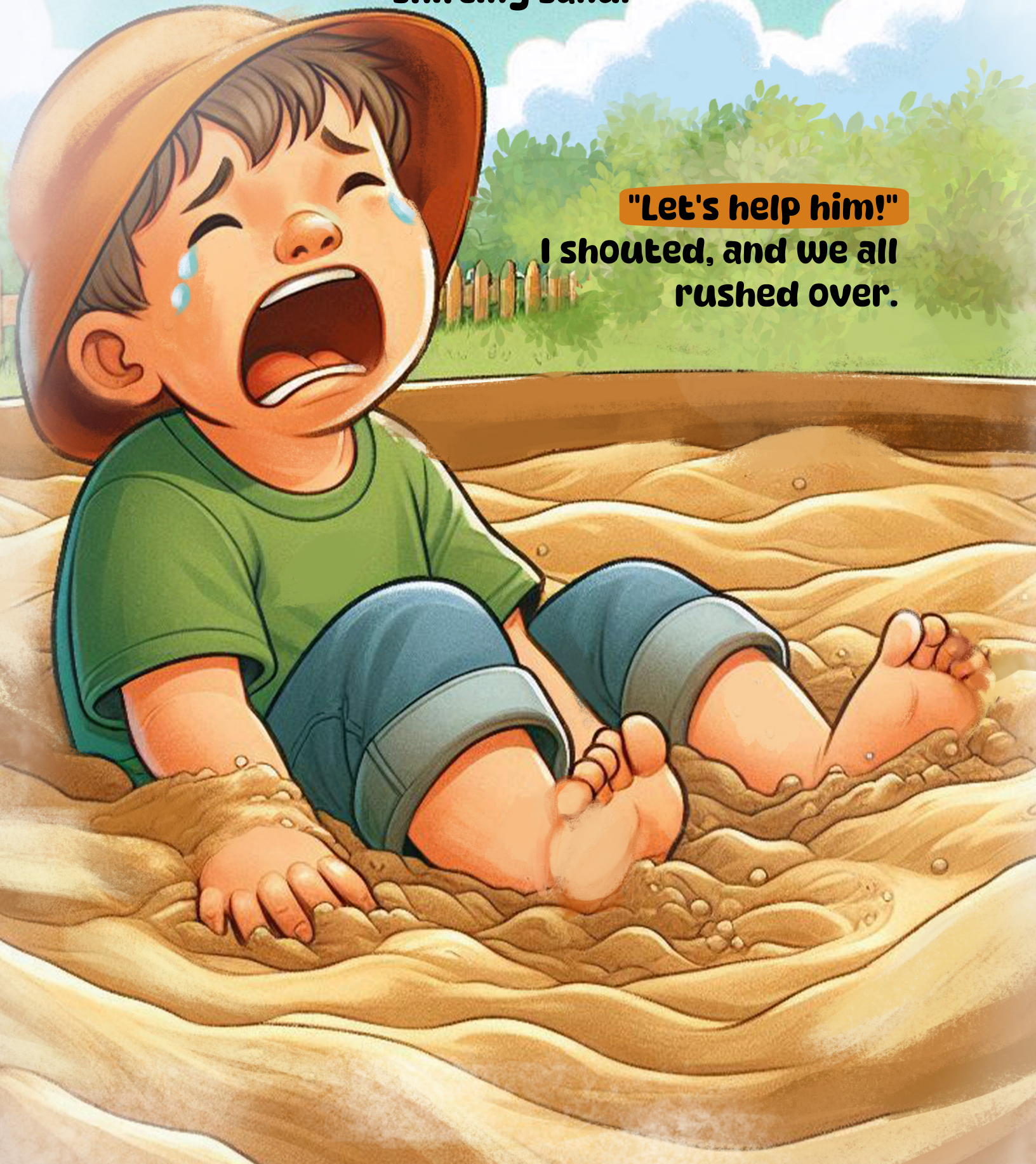
As the flower stood tall again, a butterfly fluttered by, its wings shimmering in the sunlight. We giggled, feeling as though we had stepped into a magical world.

After our adventures, we gathered under a big oak tree. I pulled out my notebook and began writing down all the acts of kindness we had done that day.

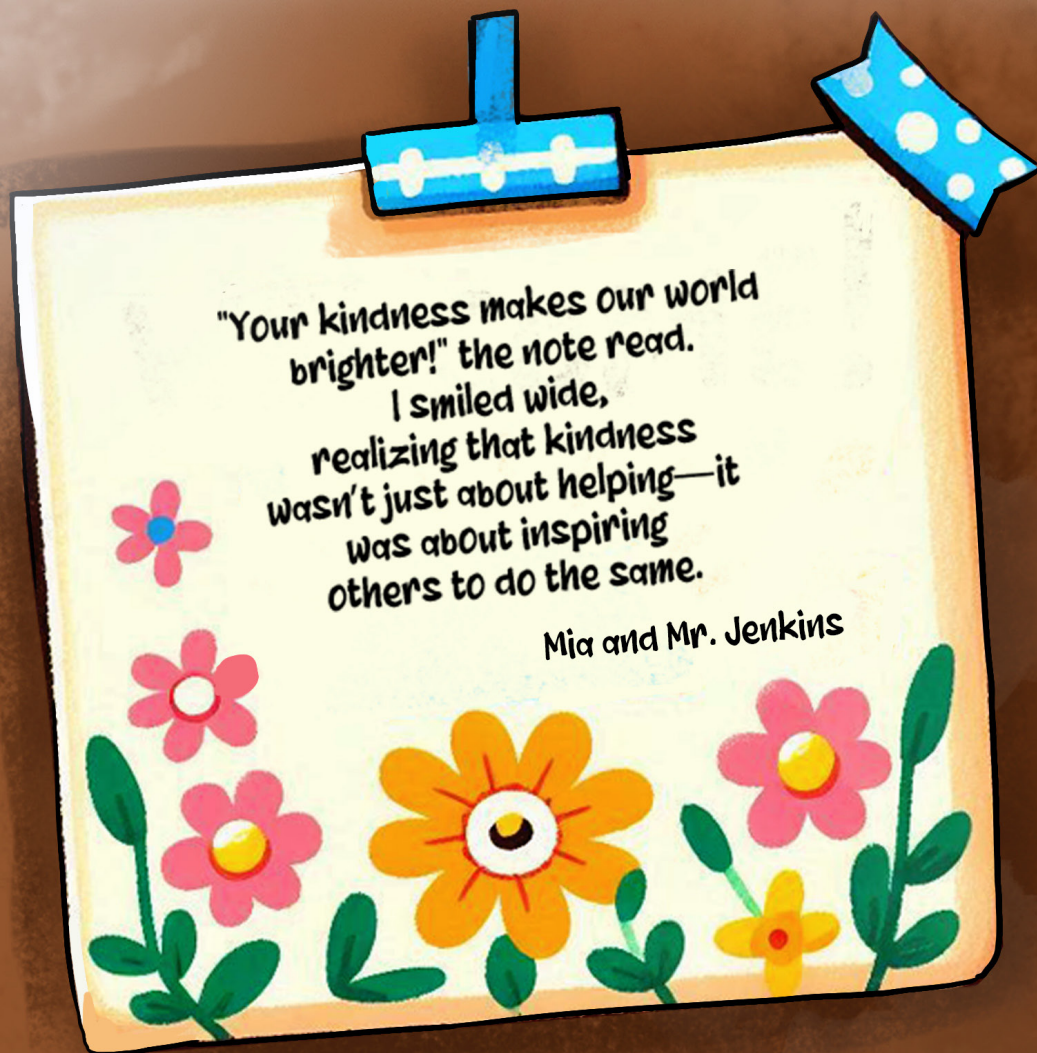
